

# Trails For All (TFA) Meeting Minutes May 11, 2021, 5:30 pm, Monthly Board Meeting Virtual Meeting via Zoom Board Approved as amended: June 8, 2021

<u>Secretary Note</u>: President PP scheduled this meeting as virtual due to Corona Virus social restrictions. Janet Smith (Vice President) chaired the meeting in the absence of Paul Parsons.

CZ moved and JA seconded that the consent agenda be approved; it passed unanimously.

## **Discussion Items/Reports:**

## 1. Trail Guide

There was discussion as to whether to go with Smart Press or Mixam for printing. HK reported that with shipping 100 copies would be about \$800. KV moved and CZ seconded to authorize HK to decide on the printer and to spend up to \$800 for 100 copies. The motion passed unanimously. [Correction at June 8 board meeting: JS moved and HK seconded that the board approved up to \$900 for the guide.]

## 2. Trail Maintenance

Jeff Outhier reported that the USFS has not yet decided to allow volunteer group to provide trail maintenance, but he expected the decision soon. JO has purchased some new Silky saws. JO noted that all gates to the forest are open. CZ suggested that our first workday to be on the Rudolph Mountain Trail in early June. JO will mark the beginning section of the trail that has been obliterated by runoff from the burn scar before our workday. JO asked TfA to work on Rudolph, Cottonwood, Comanche, and Venable Trails this year. Jess Franta (USFS) will concentrate on Goodwin, Dry, and Horn Creek. There is now a year-round fire ban in the South Colony Basin. If people are observed ignoring the fire ban, TfA volunteers are to appeal to "the authority of the resource" as noted by Leave No Trace. AT reported he encountered someone target practicing with a firearm near the Horn Creek Trail; JO said that such activity should be reported to the county sheriff and to USFS. JO will be stressing the following with trailhead signage: no shooting within 150 yards of a trail, keep dogs under control, dispose of human waste properly, and 14-day camping limit. CZ asked about workdays on



weekdays and weekends; it was suggested that we try both. KV suggested a weekend workday in conjunction with a star party. AT noted that Flipcause (website) has a volunteer tool.

#### 3. Bank Account

HK reported that the TfA account has been completely transferred to the Kirkpatrick Bank. Additional signers to the account need to stop by the bank to fill out a form and show an ID. KV moved and AT seconded a motion that PP, JS, and HK are the board members authorized to sign on the bank account; the motion passed unanimously.

## 4. Outside group funding for trail building and repair

AT asked if TfA should seek outside funding to support an outside group to provide trail maintenance. JO noted that USFA on has money only for him and Jess Franta. JO noted that the Sangre de Cristo stewardship crew that will work in South Colony this year is funded by the National Forest Foundation (?); he suggested that TfA contact Emily Olsen of the National Forest Foundation to explore funding options. CZ suggested that TfA might serve as conduit for funding, but we had hesitated to seek such funding in the past due to lack of personnel/volunteers. KV suggested that we look at a variety of options. No formal action was taken on this matter.

## 5. Bike Trails Planning Committee Report

GS reported that Luke Svare and Fletcher Jacobs are willing to come to Westcliffe to speak to the planning committee and to TfA. They suggested getting hunting, fishing, and ranching interests involved. There were 13 planning grant applications last year, and only one was funded (so competition is significant). HK suggested seeking more community interest by promoting biking on our Facebook page. GS suggested a joint community event on August 14 with Sustainable Ways and Trails for All. This received positive input, but no official decision was made.

## 6. SEEK

There was no specific information regarding a SEEK educational event for youth this summer. We still have \$7,500 set aside for SEEK. The question was asked about how long we could continue to carry these funds for SEEK, but no one knew the answer.

#### 7. Flipcause website

HK reported that we are waiting for Flipcause to move our existing website into their format. HK and AT will have access code to the new Flipcause-generated website. There will be a donation option in the new website. KV suggested that a feedback file be setup on our Google drive to give feedback about the new website. It was suggested that the new website be "kicked-off" with announcements in the Tribune, on Facebook, and in the newsletter.

## **Treasurer Action Items in April**

Banking Move to Kirkpatrick Bank – This has been completed. An initial deposit to Kirkpatrick Bank of \$10,000.00 was made April 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2021, and the remaining balance of \$9,461.64 was removed from United Business Bank (UBB) and deposited to Kirkpatrick on May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021. The UBB account was closed on May 4<sup>th</sup> as well. Unfortunately, UBB removed all access to statements online, so the April UBB statement will not be shown in this report. The Kirkpatrick April statement shows the initial deposit of \$10,000.00, and I have included a screenshot from our account showing the May 4<sup>th</sup> deposit.

I have received checks and a debit card from Kirkpatrick. The debit card is in the names of Trails for All, Herbert Kober, so I am the only person who can use the debit card I have in hand. I have not asked this of the bank yet, but I imagine debit cards could be provided to other signers as we add them, but we should discuss how many debit cards we need to have out there. Regarding the card I have, I think our standard policy applies (pre-approval for expenses), but perhaps we can make an exception for certain recurring expenses, such as Colorado state registration fees. We have already approved me paying those without preapproval, but at this time I still have to expense those. Approving me to use the debit card for those expenses would remove the expense reimbursement part of it.

<u>Colorado Non-Profit 2020 Financial Report/Registration Renewal</u> – I have completed, submitted, and paid the registration for this annual report, which is attached as a separate document to this email. The fee was \$10.00. An expense report will be submitted for reimbursement.

<u>IRS 2020 Form 990-N Filing</u> – I have completed and submitted the IRS Form 990-N annual filing, which is attached as a separate document to this email. There was no fee associated with this filing.




